Sanctuary Maintenance Position

The George C. Reifel Migratory Bird Sanctuary is looking for an individual to help maintain our buildings, minor outdoor structures and landscaped grounds at the Sanctuary. This position requires someone with a good understanding of home maintenance and handyman skills to carry out preventative maintenance and minor repairs. Experience with farm equipment, power landscaping tools and working outdoors in all seasons is a must. A valid Driver's License and reliable transportation is required (truck preferred). There is no transit to this location, and this is a very rural setting surrounded by farmland, the Fraser River and the ocean.

The general responsibility of this position is to keep buildings and other public facilities (picnic area, parking lot and driveway) in good working order. The successful applicant will be part of a small team of staff and be working in amongst the public, so a strong teamwork ethic, the ability to work in a detail-oriented self-guided manner and a sense of humour are highly desirable characteristics. Duties are diverse and change with the seasons and can include gutter cleaning, mowing and trimming of grassy edges and trees along public roadways, firewood management, garbage management, janitorial cleaning of public washrooms and other visitor structures, snow removal, repairs of fencing and other wooden outdoor structures, and troubleshooting plumbing and electrical issues to name just a few.

This position could be filled as part-time employment (a minimum of 3 days a week), but preference would be given to someone seeking full-time long-term employment if they have skills and interests that suit the job.

Interested candidates should apply immediately and be able to start in early October.

Salary is commensurate with degree of experience.
